It takes between 4 to 5 months to produce sea bass alevins, weighing 3 to 5 grams, from a hatched egg.
-  **SPECIES:** European sea bass (Dicentrarchus Labrax)

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ECLOSERIE MARINE DE GRAVELINES ICTHUS produces sea bass alevins (Dicentrarchus Labrax) and sea bass larvae (eggs just hatched): per year 20 million of 3 to 5 gr selected alevins and 400 to 500 million larvae. EMGI sells 15% of its production to farms whitening the Group and the rest is exported abroad: Croatia, Greece, Italy, Spain. The alevins are delivered in vivier trucks (water-tank trucks). The larvae from the selection are sold abroad to non-competing hatcheries.
